## Values

- In Term 1 we will be thinking about Aspiration and Caring.
- In Term 2 we will be finding out about Honesty.

## History

- To learn about significant events in History such as the Great Fire of London.
- Find out the main events and timeline of the Great fire of London.
- Find out about significant people in history, including studying Samuel Pepys.
- To use historical records to learn about events, such as Samuel Pepys' diary.

## Science

### Term 1: Identifying Plants

- To identify plants in the local environment.
- To name the parts of a plant.
- To observe and discuss the way that different plants grow.

### Term 2: Seasonal Changes

- To observe and understand seasonal changes in our locality.
- Go for an Autumn walk and make observations.

## Geography

- To learn the continents of the world and their location.
- To know that the UK is made up of four countries and be able to name the capital cities of those countries.
- To find London on a map.
- To describe and identify the landmarks of London.
- To use compass points and positional direction to navigate between London landmarks.

## Computing

- To develop our computing skills.
- In Term 1 the focus will be on word processing. Typing, opening and saving documents and editing.
- In Term 2 we will be using a variety of graphics programs.

## RE

- To think about caring for each other in different ways through stories from different religions.
- To listen to and discuss the Christmas Story and gift giving.

## Music

- Composing, creating notation and performing music.
- Sorting instruments.
- Learning songs for our Christmas performance.

## Art / DT

- Looking at architecture.
- Use viewfinders.
- Look for patterns and shapes in architecture.
- Designing a mural.
- Look at different homes and the way that they are constructed.
- Investigating how to make the interior features of houses.
- Design and make our own homes.

## PE

- We will be exploring and linking movements.
- Use equipment appropriately to land.
- Finding out why exercise is important.
