

Dear Parents/Carers,

Welcome back! We hope you have had a great Summer break and are looking forward to the new school year.

Here is some information you may find useful:

- All children in KS1 are entitled to free school dinners and will be given the day's choices during register time. Please try to ensure there is an option your child would like in advance.
- Each child will need a PE kit containing a plain white t-shirt, black shorts, jogging bottoms and trainers all clearly marked with your child's name. These will be sent home each holiday to be washed. A jumper is also required during colder months (in addition to their school jumper).
- Please help your child take part in this year's reading challenge. They may change their reading books everyday as long as they have read the book to an adult and this has been acknowledged in their reading diaries.
- Tuck shop will continue to operate on a Friday. A £5.00 tuck shop card is available; if you would like one for your child please send the money in a labelled and sealed envelope. Reminders will be sent home if your child's card is running low.
- Please make sure your child has a named and filled water bottle (only water please!) every day as it is important that they stay hydrated.
- Home-learning will be sent next week. Homework will be a spelling activity for the children to complete. In the back of their homework book we will put the reading challenge activities. Homework books need to be sent in on a Wednesday to mark and will be sent out on a Friday. In addition to reading and their spelling activity we expect children to use Times table Rockstars at least twice a week and a log in for this has already been sent home.
- Letters are sent home in book bags on a Friday.
- Children will have the option of a healthy snack every day for break time; this will be provided by the school.
- Please ensure that all items of clothing, including shoes, are labelled with your child's name. Jumpers are frequently left at school and we will always do our best to get these back to the correct children, but names do make this much easier!
- In the morning, please notify the class teacher if someone other than yourself will be collecting your child at the end of the day.

If you have any other questions, please feel free to pop in to see us at the end of the day or arrange a meeting.
